

# Art camp for kids will start June 19

Sedona youngsters will explore the art of the masters and create some masterpieces of their own in a summer art camp offered by Art for Kids and the city of Sedona.

The four-week camp will feature weekday classes from 9 a.m. to noon, June 19 to July 14, in the art classroom at Sedona Art Supply in the Bashas' shopping center.

Youngsters, ages 5 to 10, will sculpt, paint and draw following Art for Kids' "Famous Artists" curriculum in which students learn about and mimic the works of such masters as Paul Cezanne, Claude Monet, Vincent Van Gogh, Andy Warhol and Pablo Picasso.

The final two weeks will focus on the "It's Art About Me" curriculum featuring original art projects that reflect each child's individual wishes, visions and dreams.

By the end of summer camp, each student will have his or her own online gallery, and a gallery showing will be opened to families and the public.
